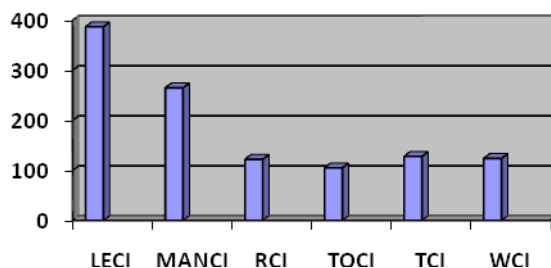
Institution Profile

- Toledo, Ohio
- Level 3 (close security)
- Male
- 1,153 inmates (as of 9/10)
 - 630 Black, 503 White, 20 Other
- 361 staff
- GRF Budget of \$23,949,346
- Only single-celled Level 3 institution

Key Statistics

- **Use of Force:** The facility reported 105 Use of Force incidents from February 2010 through July 2010, the lowest for any Level 3 institution.
- **Assaults:** The facility reported 19 inmate-on-inmate assaults and 27 inmate-on-staff assaults from August 2009 through July 2010.
- **Suicide Attempts:** The DRC reported 42 suicide attempts from January through August 2010. **Zero** suicide attempts occurred at the facility.

Key Findings

- No major safety and security concerns reported by inmates.
- Inmates reported that they were held longer in segregation than usual due to institutional overcrowding.
- Inmates in Protective Control reported that they received limited programming and that inmate food service workers "messed with" their food.
- Insects were reported in the cafeteria, showers, and housing units.
- The showers appeared to have mold around the fixtures and both inmates and staff expressed confusion regarding how to obtain appropriate cleaning chemicals.
- Overall, the institution was very clean and there was a positive, respectful relationship evident between inmates and staff.
- Despite reduced staffing and budgets, staff relayed commitment to reentry programming, providing a number of different programs for inmates.

CIIC Contacts and Concerns

From January 1, 2009 to August 17, 2010, the CIIC received **3,776 contacts** regarding the prison system.

Of that total, **176 contacts** regarded TOCI. The top three concerns reported to CIIC in regard to TOCI were **Staff Accountability, Supervision, and Healthcare.**
